



Applications for our 2026 Technical Training Classes are Now Open!

We offer two types of classes for our school audience. Based on your position and institution you may be suited to one of the following:

Technical Training: Theory, Diagnostic, and Repair

Designed primarily for **dental school service technicians and maintenance** personnel; this class covers technical theory, diagnostics, and hands-on troubleshooting. Exceptions may be made for qualified individuals from dental hygiene and assisting schools.

- July 7-10, 2026
- July 21-24, 2026

Maintenance and Operation

Designed primarily for **faculty and staff** at hygiene and assisting schools; this class covers ergonomics, seating operation, preventative maintenance, and troubleshooting. Exceptions may be made for dental school personnel.

- July 28-31, 2026

Where does the training take place?

The training will be held at A-dec's headquarters in Newberg, Oregon.

How much does it cost to attend?

There are no tuition fees for A-dec Technical Training classes, and lodging, meals, and ground transportation are always provided at no additional cost to the participants. Attendees will be responsible for getting themselves to the event (either by flying to PDX International Airport or driving directly to Newberg). A-dec will provide shuttles to and from the airport.

When should I plan to arrive?

If selected to attend, plan to arrive late afternoon on Monday. We will be hosting a welcome dinner for the group. Class runs from 8 AM to 5 PM, Tuesday-Thursday. A-dec will host a team-building excursion on Friday (details to be communicated later). The Friday excursion is optional, so if you would like to leave early you may schedule your departure for that day. Otherwise, please plan to depart for home on Saturday morning.

How do I apply?

Please note that submitting an application does not guarantee you a spot. Each year we receive more applications than we have the space for. While we do our best to accommodate each school's needs, we cannot accept every applicant each year. Evaluations in the selection process may include the applicant's tenure at their institution, whether new equipment was recently purchased, current contractual commitments, and/or the applicant's past attendance.
